Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Solid color polo-style <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ knit, collared, 2-4 buttons ★ Solid color long sleeve shirts worn UNDER polo-style shirt 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Tops that are ripped, torn, frayed, faded or with drawings/markings of any type ★ Girl's shirts that do not cover the cleavage, backside or midriff when seated, standing, bending over or stretching ★ Brand logos that are bigger than 1" in diameter
Slacks & Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Color-black, navy, gray or khaki ★ Slacks (i.e., dress slacks, Dockers-style, corduroys) or Bermuda shorts ★ Shorts must be no more than two inches above the knee while sitting ★ Girls may wear capris ★ All pants/shorts must be worn at the natural waistline 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Knit pants or shorts ★ Athletic-style joggers or shorts ★ Baggy, sagging or tight pants ★ Hip-huggers and low-riders ★ Camouflage/military clothing or sweat pants ★ Ripped, torn, faded and/or not hemmed ★ No wording on seat of pants
Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Girls may choose to wear to wear skirts instead of pants ★ Color-black, navy, gray or khaki ★ Girls' skirts must be no more than two inches above the knee while sitting (this includes slits) ★ All skirts must be worn at the waist 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Skirts more than two inches above the knee while sitting (this includes slits) ★ Hip-hugger style skirts ★ See-through skirts that do not have appropriate slips under them
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Shoes are to be worn at all times ★ Athletic shoes may be worn if they are in good condition ★ Shoes must be made of firm enough material to prevent sharp objects from penetrating the sole ★ Shoes that have laces or buckles must be properly fastened and properly tied 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Spiked heels, house slippers, plastic shower shoes, "flip flops" of any type and thong type sandals
Socks/hose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Hose should be a solid color which may be white, black, navy, gray or natural ★ Socks should be worn with shoes, with the exception of sandals for girls ★ Boys must wear socks at all times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Decorated hose ★ Socks with toes
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Hairstyles are to be in good taste and modest ★ Boys' hair must be cut above the collar, eyebrows and ears ★ Young men may have well-groomed facial hair (no longer than ½") ★ Sideburns may extend no lower than the bottom of the ear opening 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Extremes or fads in hairstyles that are designed to attract attention (i.e., spiking, unnatural colors, designs shaved into hair, feathers) <p>Note: "extreme" and "fad" hairstyles are determined by LCS standards and school administration.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ No braids or accessories for boys in hair
Earrings, Tattoos and Makeup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Girls may wear earrings on ears only and no more than two earrings in each ear ★ Girls' makeup and jewelry must be in good taste 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Facial piercings ★ Chains and/or metal decorations added to or part of clothing ★ Excessive makeup and jewelry ★ No temporary markings or drawings on any part of the body (sharpies/ink pens) ★ Earrings, fingernail polish or makeup on boys; no gauges

Sports events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Extra-curricular sports clothing must be modest ★ Shorts are to have a minimum of a 7" inseam ★ Shirts (tops) must have at least 3" of material over the shoulder 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Boys: removing shirts indoors or outdoors in mixed company ★ Girls: midriff visible at any time
Jackets/ Outerwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ To & from school - Any reasonable jacket/outerwear ★ School hours - LCS hooded-fleece jackets, provided by the school, 8:05-3:00 ★ Dress Your Way Days - any jacket that meets Dress Code standards for condition, fit, & suitability 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Non LCS jackets (except on Dress Your Way Days) ★ Caps, hats, bandanas and/or bulky coats worn inside during the school day ★ No pullover sweatshirts w/exception of "Dress Your Way" days or Fridays ★ Hoods may not be worn in the building
PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ T-shirt ★ Basketball-length athletic shorts for boys and girls 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ T-shirts with questionable wording or graphics ★ Shorts with less than a 7" seam
Friday Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Blue jeans/shorts may be worn on Friday ★ LCS T-shirts, LCS sweatshirts, or LCS windbreakers or LCS pullover hoodies ★ SCC and HCAA t-shirts of which LCS is a representative of the organization ★ Regular Dress Code <p>Note: Friday Dress is a privilege that can be lost.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Knit pants, shorts or leggings ★ Baggy, sagging or tight jeans ★ Hip-huggers and low-riders ★ Jeans/shorts with rips/frays worn without leggings underneath* ★ Any holes in jeans/shorts larger than palm of students hand* ★ Holes on the back of jeans/shorts ★ Shorts/skirts/skortts that are more than 2" above the knees ★ Clothing that is tight fitting or not modest

(Example: leggings, etc. may be worn underneath.)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Leggings as pants ★ Pajamas and costumes ★ Baggy, sagging or tight jeans ★ Hip-huggers and low-riders ★ Jeans/shorts with rips/frays worn without leggings underneath* ★ Any holes in jeans/shorts larger than palm of students hand* ★ Holes on the back of jeans/shorts ★ Wording on seat of pants ★ Shorts/skirts that are more than 2" above the knees ★ Tank tops and spaghetti straps ★ Shirts with questionable wording/graphics ★ Clothing that is tight fitting or not modest
Alternate Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Special occasions that have been approved by the administration, i.e., Spirit Week, seasonal days, sports days ★ See Appendix B for detailed information 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Clothing that is tight fitting or not modest ★ Clothing that does not fit the guidelines for the special occasion
